



























Find Yourself in Sanctuary

Utopia lives in southern Indiana

New Harmony was the site of two early 19th century communal living experiments and remains a delightful utopian getaway full of history, activities, art and nature. Daily tours begin at 1 p.m. in the Atheneum Visitors Center, designed by renowned architect Richard Meier.

Tours visit several historic sites such as:

- David Lenz House, built circa 1822 (Fully restored, includes authentic Harmonist furniture)
- Maximilian-Bodmer Exhibit, a collection documenting an 1830s expedition, housed in the 1845 Lichtenberger Building








Harmonie State Park

Astounding Natural Woodlands
Harmonie State Park is a place of
deep ravines, towering trees, abundant
wildlife, and modern campground
amenities including water and electric;
cabins for rent; hiking, biking, mountain
biking, and horse trails; a nature center
for kids; numerous playgrounds; picnic
areas; pond and bank fishing; and a boat
ramp on the Wabash.

"Harmonie State Park, as well as the rest of Posey County, is situated in a unique geographic location," says Amelia Wildeman, the park's interpretive naturalist. "It's the northernmost region for some plants and animals and southernmost region for others. You find things here that you won't find anywhere else in Indiana."

Located just a few miles south of New Harmony, the park is made up of 3,465 acres that include a dry upland area, a lower swampy slough area that borders the Wabash River, and many hills and forest in between. The defining feature of the park is its steep ravines that were carved by glacial meltwaters at the end of the last ice age. There is a

lot of sandstone in the bedrock, and the lowlands near the river have very sandy soil.

Campers enjoy its relaxing tranquility, and a beautiful campground with spacious campsites, and many amenities, including full electric, water, clean bath houses, and a dump station.

Kids and their parents love it for its friendly, safe environment, many playgrounds, nature center and countless activities available for children of all ages.

The campground's rustic cabins are fully equipped and affordable – ideal for those who want to get away from it all, and popular for such things as girls weekend out, family reunions, or wedding parties.

Hikers can enjoy more than 40 miles of trails that range from very easy to moderate. Harmonie State Park is one of the best mountain biking destinations in the area. Other cycling options range from a paved nine-mile loop with challenging climbs to leisurely rides

on flat, paved lanes through beautiful scenery. The fishing is great at the park's scenic ponds, Rush Creek, or from the banks of the Wabash River. Two horse trails round out options for getting out in the park's unique and beautiful ecosystem.

Or, visitors can just take a leisurely drive around the park, which is especially nice around sunset when you will likely see more than a few white-tailed deer. A nice paved road loops across the high land, up and down the wooded hills, through the scenic valleys, all the way to a great picnic area and short walk on the Wabash river's edge.



The Point

The Point is where the Wabash River meets the Ohio, most often the first thing people notice when they look at a map of Indiana.

Today, Point Township is a sparsely populated home to fertile farmland and incredible wildlife and nature preserves. It's a fantastic place for outdoor activities, including boating, kayaking, hunting, fishing, hiking, and birdwatching.

Although the publicly accessible properties in the lands between the rivers are generally not very well developed, there are fantastic sightseeing opportunities. Casual visitors can take a fascinating drive that passes Hovey Lake, with its still water and ghostly trees, the Ohio River, a major dam, and cypress sloughs right out of the Deep South.

Plan a drive through Point Township during your stay. Roads are paved to Hovey Lake and the J.T. Meyers Locks and Dam.



Hovey Lake

Hovey Lake is a 1,400-acre oxbow lake notable for its water fowl and other wildlife, great fishing, canoeing and kayaking, and scenic beauty. The lake's distinguishing feature is its vast number of cypress and other trees that are partially submerged in the water.

Hovey Lake is an excellent spot for sightseeing, hiking, bird watching, picnicking, and kayaking, as well as hunting and fishing. There is a levee that serves as an interesting trail where it is common to see a nice variety of wildlife, especially herons.

Bald cypress trees stand in and around a large portion of the lake, providing a scenic backdrop for wildlife and a perfect habitat for crappies.

The lake is part of the Hovey Lake Fish and Wildlife Area, which includes several other properties as well and is devoted to maintaining wildlife in Posey County for residents and visitors alike.



Cypress Slough

Posey County's Cypress Sloughs provide the experience of a Deep South ecosystem in Southern Indiana. Magnificent Bald Cypress trees, and their attendant knees, line the water and provide important habitat for an intriguing variety of wetland plants and animals, some that make their home there, others that just pass through.

No two cypress sloughs are identical. But in general, they are areas of slightly lower elevation than the surrounding land. The Bald Cypress is a cousin to the California redwood, a deciduous conifer which loses its leaves in winter. Cypress trees are known for their "knees," woody projections which are part of the root system but pop out of the ground in the area surrounding the trees.


